Draft minutes of the EUGC committee meeting on 10 September 2018, 12h30, Il Ramo Verde

- 1. EUGC competitions and calendar
 - a. <u>Slow play</u> (revising our internal rules):
 The committee decided to revisit the issue once the R&A rules' revision for 2019 have entered into force.
 - b. Triangular matches:

The committee noted that the three clubs (EUGC, IGC and MUGS) have different ideas about the event: whereas the EUGC considers this to be primarily an event, which should be open to a maximum number of players, the two other clubs are more interested in setting up a competition with a limited number of players. As the EUGC has more members than the other clubs, the committee observed that the organisers, on occasions, "borrowed" EUGC players. This should subject to authorisation by the committee.

c. Club Championship

The Club Championship, first category, was set-up as net stroke play competition. This was contested during the prize giving by the wife of a player, arguing that the competition should have considered the gross results. However, the EUGC committee emphasised that the club is perfectly entitled to organise the club championship based on net results.

d. Winter Cup prizes

The committee would like to apologise that it did not hand out the 2017/2018 Winter Cup prizes earlier. They will now be distributed during the Prix du Club on 21 October. The winners' list can be found on the club's website. The treasurer will buy the prizes for the prize giving.

e. European Parliamentary Golf Championship:

The President reported back from this golfing event, which took place in July. More than 80 players (former and current members of Parliament) from over 10 countries participated. The EUGC was the main organiser. According to the feedback, the event was a resounding success.

f. Ambassadors' Cup:

Those of our players, who participated in the mid-week event, were happy with the course of events. The EUGC sponsored the organisers with golf balls.

g. Ostend:

For the first time, the Golf Club of Ostend surprised the EUGC at the last minute by charging a green fee of approximately EUR 21. The EUGC would like to maintain the good and cordial relationship with Ostend. The committee decided that information on the playing formula and green fee should be collected at an early stage in order to avoid surprises.

h. Dunkirk weekend:

At the stage of discussion only 12 members had registered for the weekend.

i. Prix GETRONIX, Prix INTRASOFT:

The secretary will contact André MAMBOURG to ensure his presence and the presence of the sponsors.

j. 10. Michel BERRYER competition:

Committee members will invite the sponsors, with which they have been in contact over the year, to the Michel-BERRYER-Memorial.

k. Prix du Club:

The competition will be played as a three or four-ball scramble, depending on the number of registered players. The committee aims creating flights composed of players from all three categories, if possible.

As it is traditional, prizes will be handed out for the competition of the day and for the astrix* competitions. The winners of the asterix* competitions will be invited.
