These non-sponsored competitions which are identified by an asterix (*) in the calendar run from April to September and there are three playing categories: 0 - 18.4; 18.5 - 26.4; and 26.5 - 36. At the end of the season, prizes are awarded in each category based on the best five scores, irrespective of the category in which they are played. A player's final ranking will be in the category in which they played the majority of their five best rounds.

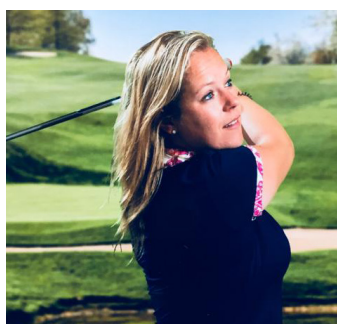


Newcomers' event
