1. Golfing programme 2023 (state-of-play)

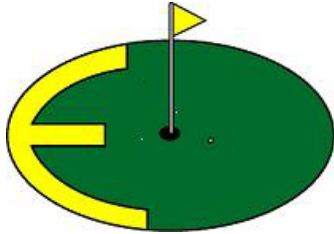

- The latest version of the golf calendar is available on the EUGC website.

As he is the Seniors' Captain in the National Golf Club, the committee asked Peter BAADER to enquire if the EUGC could obtain a special green fee quote.

The Ternesse Golf & Country Club does not accept groups during the weekend.

The Hulencourt Golf Club only sells packages (green fee + lunch) for €150. The committee members did not find such an offer attractive.

- The Committee decided that the Club would sponsor the following five competitions: Avernas, Tervuren, Louvain-La-Neuve, Limburg and Falnuée. These competitions will therefore no longer be played as an asterisque-competition. For the competitions the club will use its standard categories; The prizes will be champagne.
- The committee also decided that the club would try to organise a golfing weekend in South-East England in September. The President would ask Dominic DOYLE if he could be of assistance.

2. Membership situation

- At the time of the meeting 98 players had renewed their membership.

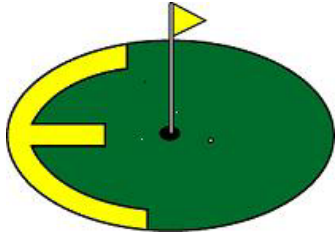
3. Preparation of the General Assembly

- The Committee confirmed that the 2023 General Assembly would be held in the restaurant “Il Ramo Verdee”, Rue de Toulouse 46, 1040 Brussels on 23 February 2023. The President would send out the invitation via i-Golf. The documents for the general assembly, notably the agenda, the budget execution, and the menu, would be made available in the members’ section of the public EUGC website. Only members who have paid their annual membership fee would be allowed to vote.

The menu costs €55 of which €10 would be taken over by the club for the paid-up members.

4. Obligation to be present at the prize giving

The committee decided that only those members can be nominated club champion and/or winners of the Ladies’ and Men’s competitions (played the same day) who are in attendance during the prize giving.
