

EUGC golfing weekend in Chantilly 18-20 October 2024



275 km south of Brussels you'll find the city of Chantilly, a well-known tourist attraction, with its castle and impressive horse stables (<https://www.chantilly-senlis-tourisme.com/>) - and a few rather nice golf courses in its vicinity.

Château de Raray Golf Club

(Domaine de Raray, 4 rue Nicolas de Lancy 60810 RARAY tel. : +33- 3 44 54 70 61)



Château de Raray Golf Course spans 165 hectares in the Hauts-de-France region's Oise department. You will find yourself on the property of the 17th century Château de Raray, a listed historic monument.

The 18-holes golf course is called "The Unicorn", in reference to the ornaments of the "Porte de Diane", a listed monumental portal delimitating the entrance to the practice.

The par-72 course was built in 1987 by Patrice Leglise and offers an "English feeling" with wide fairways and strategically positioned bunkers (length: 5800 meters from the yellow tees, and 4850 meters from the red tees).

Golf Club d'Apremont

(Chemin Départemental D606E 60300 Apremont, tel. : +33- 3.44.25.61.11)



Spread over 80 of the 120 hectares of the estate, the Apremont course is an elegant and demanding course in pure Anglo-Saxon tradition.

Designed by John Jacobs and Olivier Dongradi, the layout is both simple and formidable and promises gaming pleasure for both beginners and experienced players.

The course, 5800 meters long from the white tees (red tees: 5060 meters), guarantees a wide variety of shots for any golf enthusiast. If the first 9 holes of the circuit offer a series of doglegs perfectly separated by the trees, the last 9 holes present a more rectilinear layout where your swing will be put to the test.

Golf de la Forêt de Chantilly

(4 Route d'Apremont, 60500 Vineuil Saint Firmin, tel. : +33-3- 44.58.47.74)

This 18-hole course (6181 meters from the white tees - Par 72), designed in 1991 by T. Huau et R. Nelson, will appeal to players of all levels.

Built on sandy soil the course has 14 holes on the edge of the forest and 4 holes with so-called "garden to garden" architecture "à la française" with ponds and canals, located opposite the Mercure Chantilly Convention and Resort Hotel.
