

Each winter, between November and March, the committee organises a "Winter Cup" consisting of 5 tournaments played at Pierpont.

This year, for the first time, EUGC members will have the possibility of playing in the MUGS winter golf competitions and reciprocally MUGS members with us. This will effectively add 10 extra winter golf possibilities to our calendar. While we play together to increase the possibilities of playing golf and registering good scores, our winter competitions remain separate.

Rounds played with MUGS can count as qualifying scores for the EUGC winter cup competition but in order to qualify for a EUGC prize members must have played at least 2 of their rounds with the EUGC at Pierpont.

This event is played by EUGC in stable ford and 3 categories 0 - 16.4; 16.5 - 24.4; and 24.5 – 36.

At the end of March, prizes are awarded in each category based on the best three scores, irrespective of the category in which they are played.

A player's final ranking will be in the category in which they played the majority of their three best rounds.

In the event of a tie in points, the lower handicap prevails. If by chance there is also a tie in handicap, the highest number of tournaments played during the winter prevails. If by chance, the tie persists, a draw will determine the ranking.

The final classification is established the day after the last friendly meeting with the points and handicap of that day.

The number of prizes depends on the number of players.

From 1 to 7 players = 1 prize; from 8 to 14 players = 2 prizes; from 15 players = 3 prizes. This is valid in each category.
