1. Membership situation 2024

- > At the day of the meeting 118 members had joined the club
- > The committee decided that Dominic DOYLE would handle and follow-up all expression of interest in becoming a member of the EUGC.

2. Golfing programme 2024 (state-of-play), and 2025 programme

The committee decided that the "Prix du Club" would be played as a two-ball scramble.



- > Following the competition the club would hand out the prizes for the competitions which were played over the year, i. e.
 - Winter Cup 2023/2024
 (cat. 1=1 prize, €120; cat. 2=2 prizes, €120 & €80; cat. 3=2 prizes, €120 & €80)
 - Astérisques
 (cat. 1=3 prizes, € 180 &€120 & €80; cat. 2=2 prizes, €180 & €120, cat. 3=3 prizes, € 180 &€120 & €80)
 - Match play competition (two prizes, €150, €100)
- The committee agreed to organise a dinner on the occasion of the "Prix du Club" competition. The President will ask for a menu proposal.
- The committee evaluated how the additional events set up in August were received. There was no interest in playing fixtures during the week. In future the club's programming should no longer foresee a summer break.find solutions
- The committee decided to open the Winter Cup events to MUGS ("Monsanto Europe Golf Society", one of the two other clubs without a course) players. In return, EUGC members can participate in the MUGS "Eclectic" winter events which are played in Rigenée on Fridays. Dominic DOYLE was asked to find solutions for technical questions related to registering for the competitions and encoding the results. The "Eclectic" winter fixtures will add about 10 events to the EUGC winter calendar.

3. AFGOLF

Presidents' lunch (4/9/2024): The AFGOLF President awaits a meeting with the new Walloon minister of sports. Other issues discussed: sustainability (water, pesticides, damage caused by animals, renewal of the green surfaces), different forms of playing golf and shorter rounds
